Chromebooks will be going home with the 9th grade students. WLC continues to move forward with its 1:1 efforts. Next year, it is hoped that all students in grades 9-12 will have Chromebooks and will be able to use them in school and home. Expectations have been made clear to all ninth graders. Students must:

- Ensure their Chromebook is charged for school.
- Ensure their Chromebook is safe from damage, liquids and drops.
- Ensure their Chromebook is secure and safe from theft.
- Report any damage immediately so it can be repaired.
- Report theft or loss immediately so it can be reported to the police for investigation.

There will be a limited number of chargers available in the library where students may leave their device for charging. But it is the student's responsibility and the expectation that they have it charged and ready to go for school each day.

Last summer, Amy White, Library Media Specialist, participated in CS4HS - a Google funded professional development opportunity instructing teachers on Mobile Computer Science Principles. As part of this program, WLC now has over a dozen android devices on loan from the UNH STEM Discovery Lab's Lending Library. Students in the Middle School Coding Club are learning MIT App Inventor and a few students in Mrs. Bujak's 8th grade Language Arts Class are coding apps as a part of their book reports. Students who are interested in learning MIT App Inventor are invited to stop in the library and talk to Mrs. White.
