WLC News:

The District met at WLC on Monday August 26th. Teachers and staff received training on the usage of Epi-Pens, blood-borne pathogens, and mandated reporting of suspected abuse.

On Tuesday, August 27th teachers were involved in the meet and greet events held in both the middle school and the high school. In the afternoon all teachers received Power School Competency Training.

Wednesday August 28th the staff spent the day setting up their classrooms.

The Meet and Greet for all 6^{th} grade and 9^{th} grade students went very well. The attendance for this event was over 75%.

The students returned to school on Thursday August 29th. We kicked school off with an all-school assembly. WLC welcomed all new students which included the 6th graders. We asked the students to focus this year on three life lessons that are taught every day, attendance and being on time, being respectful, and always doing your best. Ms. Ballou spoke about new SEER Expectations. I ended the assembly reading a first grade picture book titled, "First Day Jitters." Overall it was a very positive start to the year.

Technology Report:

Phone transition is complete; all district phones are VoIP with TDS. This enables 4 digit dialing between schools and the SAU Office.

New domain controllers are being configured and will be in place soon; this connects all our district computers to enable easier backups and storage of our data. This will help us in getting our emergency data recovery plans in place.

WLC technology is working well; we have a few minor issues which will be solved in the coming days.

We will be assessing the networks in the district to make sure that our data flows more consistently, this is to help make sure we continue to meet state requirements.

Equipment disposal has taken place and most of the old equipment that was no longer functioning has been removed. We will continue to keep up with this process

The WJAA (Wilton Junior Athletic Association) donated a pair of soccer nets, with a net worth of \$159.95.

JV Soccer Update

Last month Coach Draper and Mr. Miller approached the School Board requesting funding for a Girls JV Soccer Team. This decision was based on the number of girls that signed up in the preseason to play. Several girls did not show up to participate, leaving the numbers small enough for everyone to make the varsity team. This worked out well for the boys' soccer team. Surprisingly over 30 boys showed up for tryouts and have stuck it out. After consulting with Superintendent Tyrie and Athletic Director Brice Miller it was decided we add a JV Boys Soccer Team in place of the Girl's JV Soccer Team. Mr. Miller is in the process of scheduling games and will stay within the budget parameters set forth by the board at the August 13th meeting. This includes a \$1,000 stipend for a coach. The boys have 2 fundraisers lined up to buy additional JV jerseys and game shorts to match the new varsity home jerseys purchased this spring, so no additional cost will come to the district in that regard.
