

## Nathan Gill—Grade 5

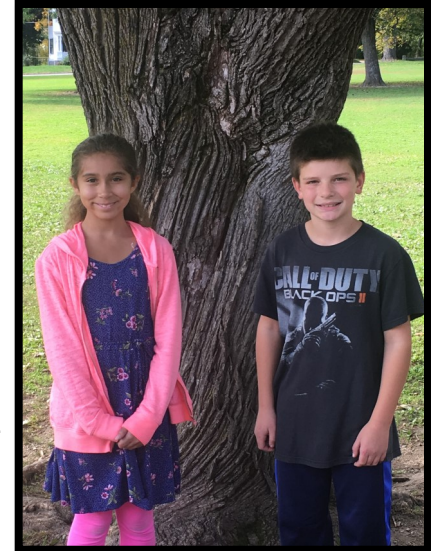
Nathan works extremely hard in the classroom. He completes his assignments on time, asks for help when he needs it, and consistently does his best.

Aynsley is very cooperative. She can work with all students. She is able to listen to others opinions and agree or disagree. Other students respect her opinions and enjoy working with her.

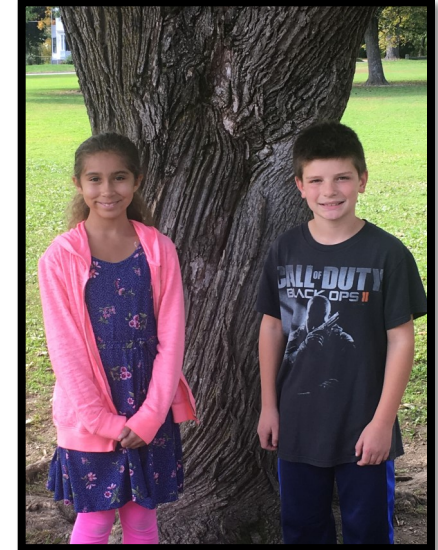
Aynsley is assertive. Although she is very mild mannered, she will stick up for herself and more importantly her friends and classmates. She makes sure everyone is treated fairly.
