To donate candy:

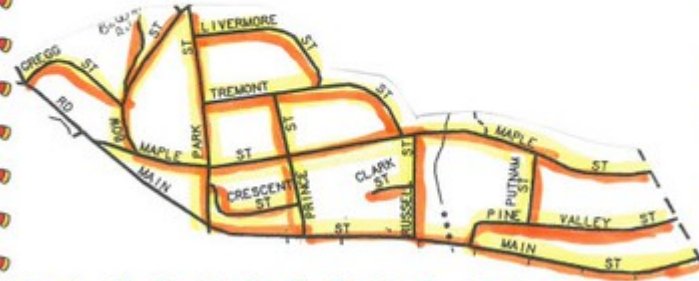
Donations must be in the original sealed package and dropped off at Wilton's Library, Town Hall, Police Station and at Lyndeborough Town Hall from Saturday October 9th to Friday October 22nd.

To qualify to receive candy:

Check the map to see if your household will qualify for donated candy. The streets highlighted in yellow are included. If you are an adult at an approved address, and **sign up with the Library by calling 654-2581 or emailing wiltonlibrarynh@gmail.com on or before Friday October 22nd**, you qualify!

To pick up candy:

Pick-up will be available during regular Library hours between Tuesday, October 26th & Saturday, October 30th. Only registered households may pick up. Proof of residence will be required. An adult must pick up the candy, and there will be only one pick-up per household. Amounts distributed will depend on the amount donated.

MORE INFORMATION

- Please have your child bring his/her costume to school on Friday, October 29th.
 - They will be getting dressed after lunch.
 - Children are asked not to bring any accessories (swords, wands, props).
 - We have extra staff to support students as they get ready.
 - Parents and community members are welcome to line the streets to enjoy the parade as we move through town.
 - Those watching the parade are encouraged to dress up too:)
 - The Fire Chief and Police Chief will lead the parade.
- Parade will begin promptly at 1:00pm
- The route will be the same as it has been in the recent past.
 - Staff and students will exit the building in the front and proceed to walk to Tremont Street. Next we will take a left onto Park Street. Once at the Legion students will take a right onto Maple Street and walk to Main Street. Students will go around the traffic signal on Main Street and make their way down Main Street towards the fire department. Finally, students will take a left onto Prince Street and head back to FRES.
- Once back at FRES students will be directed to the Flat where they are welcome to enjoy Apple Cider, Donuts and apples.
- Staff and students will re enter the building at 2:00 pm to prepare for our regular dismissal time

- *Please note: dismissal will stay the same. If you would like to change your students' dismissal procedure please contact the front **office before noon** to make those necessary arrangements. This is typically a very hectic time and student safety is our primary concern. Thanks for your help with this.*
