## WLC News:

### Common Core Standards Workshops:

- March 6<sup>th</sup>: members from each department attended the Seresc Common Core Workshop and will be sharing information with their department.
- March 11<sup>th</sup> 3-5pm: Leadership Team of which includes Department Heads, Competency Committee, and MS Team Leaders attended an in- school workshop run by the DOE and Seresc. This presentation was focused on a math CCSS workshop that works through understanding the standards, doing some gap analysis, and planning for transition.
- March 14<sup>th</sup>: Staff-in-Service Day for Full Faculty was held and focused on Common Core Standards. The workshop was once again run by the DOE and Seresc. It included a presentation to the full faculty in the morning and break- out sessions in the afternoon.

There was a lengthy discussion about what the issue is around the term "Body of Evidence." The burning question asked was, "how do you know that students have passed a competency?" For the next PLC on March 19<sup>th</sup> each teacher will bring a copy of their competencies and a list of "how teachers know that students know what is being taught" and example(s) of that.

There was a brief discussion on the incomplete policy. The thought was raised about allowing incompletes to be open longer than 2 weeks.
