Good afternoon,

I wanted to make you aware that a high school student has tested positive for COVID-19. This student began to feel symptoms on Friday December 11. The student does not ride the bus. The school administration is doing contact tracing and is identifying students who may have come into contact with this student while at school. The standard for contact is that other students would have been within six feet of the student for 10 or more minutes on any one day.

Our school administration will be making contact with all families and staff that we believe have come into contact with this student this afternoon. Those students and staff will be required to quarantine from tomorrow through Monday December 21, with students returning on Monday December 21. During the period of quarantine if your child experiences any of the following you should contact your health care provider and schedule a COVID-19 test. The symptoms include.

New loss of taste or smell	Coughing	Fever	Chills
Body aches	Sneezing	Headaches	Stomach Distress
Shortness of breath	Diarrhea	Sore throat	Fatigue
