- 1. Chair Browne called the Budget Committee to order at 6:37 p.m.

A MOTION was made by Kevin Boette to accept the minutes as amended; Seconded by Dennis Golding. Voting: All Ayes with one abstention (Kevin Boette). Motion passed.

32 4. Public Hearing Preparation

33 Chair Browne prepared the Public Hearing Presentation with the help of Christine Tiedemann and reviewed with the Committee and asked if the Committee would like additional information put in 34 to the presentation. There is an increase of almost \$130K over the last fiscal year which is 35 approximately 1% and represents \$163K reduction from the SAU originally proposed. This is in 36 line with the typical unexpended fund balances. We are just asking them to tighten the belt just a 37 small amount. She reviewed what the Budget Committee is supporting, areas of increase in the 38 39 budget and areas of decrease in the budget. We have to take into consideration State and Federal 40 funding decreases due to decline enrollments and shifts in funding formulas. Mr. Boette suggested that we point out that to reach out to elected officials in Concord because the biggest impact to 41 their taxes is from Concord balancing their budget and not funding things that they funded in 42 previous years. They are not decreasing our obligation at the local level. The "net" impact on 43 taxes was reviewed and discussed. Ms. Post suggested that we note on the slide that school taxes 44 are 80% of their property tax bill. A discussion whether the statement was misleading or not and it 45 was agreed the statement needs to be reworked and clarified. Regarding revenue, Ms. Post 46 suggested that it should be explained that it changes year to year due to student enrollment 47 48 numbers. Operating Budget was reviewed as mostly federally mandated and previously

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negotiated contracts. Chair Browne stated at this time we have control of \$685K. Contract 49 negotiations need to be considered carefully. Our salary and benefits are huge and we need to 50 hold administration accountable for making sure that they are hiring and paying for who and what 51 52 they need. She felt the Committee has done a lot to support the school over the years and reviewed slides with the information to be presented. Minor corrections were made in these 53 54 slides. Chair Browne will get the tax impact for Warrant Article #05 and Ms. Post asked that the 55 work be show as to how the number was calculated. She will add an introductory slide and outline the process for this season. 56

58 Chair Browne reference Warrant Article 06 Change Apportionment Basis with 3-year rolling 59 averages and obtained clarification that if we vote "no" we are stuck for 5 years. If we do not put 60 up the warrant article we can visit it next year and she asked for a motion.

A Motion was made by Lisa Post to not recommended and request that the Warrant Article 06 is
 removed; Seconded by Edwina Hastings. Voting: All in favor. Motion passed unanimously.

Chair Browne said the School Board has not voted on our number but they hope to vote on it
Wednesday before the Public Hearing. She did feel it was important that our numbers align for the
District Meeting. Ms. Post felt it was important to show that the student enrollment numbers and
Chair Browne indicated she will have additional slides prepared for enrollment, staffing and test scores
if questions arise we will have the data to speak to it. Ms. Post asked that the final slides be sent out
the Committee members.
