Adamlesli Lavallee suggested repaving the parking lot. Mr, Rockwood expressed that he did not support that if it has not been discussed with the taxpayers. Committee discussed spending down the balance prudently at the end of the year for things that are needed or were budgeted for, vs. returning the maximum to the taxpayers. Ms. Browne said that it's been done both ways in that the district used to spend down the balance but not recently.
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24 25		Mr. Weaver stated that there aren't line item transfers any further but we have the ability to overspend certain line items in case there are things we need. District in the process of hiring a new athletic director and committee requested the new

hire be part of the budget presentation next fiscal year. Mr. Weaver also explained that the school board was getting new
quotes on repair of the tennis courts given concerns raised by two parents about the approved plan to remove them.

Ms. LaPlante provided an overview of some of the unspent maintenance line items for the FY completing June '22. Many of the items were put off in case the boiler failed so there would be enough funds to cover that. Committee and Superintendent agreed that a discussion with the BC should occur in April '23 and potentially the School Board as running a large surplus could allow for some spending to occur on items that are needed that would otherwise roll into the next budget year. Mr. Ryan stated that the BC should be thanking the district for their smart spending and that the actual spend is not the responsibility of this committee.

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
