On April 20th, 33-7th and 8th grade students embarked on a fabulous four day trip (led by the Cheshire YMCA) to historical, educational, and interesting sites throughout Pennsylvania. Several days were spent exploring historic Philadelphia and visiting places like the National Mint, the Benjamin Franklin Museum, the First US Post Office, Independence Hall, and the Liberty Bell. Students also got a taste for big city life during lunch at the Reading Terminal Market, a fabulous indoor market jam-packed with every food imaginable. They also enjoyed a sunset walking tour of the Benjamin Franklin Parkway which commenced at the beautiful Philadelphia City Hall and progressed to the famous steps of the Philadelphia Museum of Art; along the way enjoying sculptures, fountains, city lights, and the prep work for the NFL Draft that took place there last weekend.

Students spent their nights in Lancaster County where they had the opportunity to eat some delicious regionally inspired cuisine, and observe and learn about the Amish ways of life. On Saturday evening students dressed up and attended a live showing of the musical "My Fair Lady".

The highlight of the trip for most however, was probably the day spent at Gettysburg National Military Park and Museum. Despite the wet weather students were enraptured with the miles of monuments and the stories surrounding them. They thoroughly enjoyed the interactive museum and expressed their wishes for even more time there. They were awestruck by the Gettysburg Cyclorama- an oil painting in the round, that is longer than a football field and higher than a four story building and depicts the 3rd day of battle and the event know as *Pickett's Charge*.

The four days were chock full of lots of walking, good food, and many gift shops. We even stopped at Valley Forge on the homeward bound trip on Sunday. Most importantly the trip was filled with many, many learning experiences related to school and related to self. A feeling of camaraderie developed among the students and chaperones, and could be observed in the halls on Monday morning as well. This was an experience that many will remember for years to come.
