WLC Principal Report
August 8, 2017

We've been very busy this summer reviewing teacher applications and conducting interviews. The following positions have been filled: HS/MS Spanish, HS/MS Industrial Arts, HS Language Arts, MS Science, MS Math, MS Language Arts, and HS Social Studies. Long-term substitutes have been hired for MS Guidance, and MS Math. I'm excited about the new additions to our WLC family. Two positions are left, HS Math and Alternative Education Specialist.

NEASC is scheduled to visit WLC in the fall of 2019. Prior to their visit, starting second semester of this coming year, we will be conducting a required Self-Study. As part of the accreditation process a NEASC representative will meet with the faculty on the September 29th early release day. The central purpose of the self-study is to draw and substantiate conclusions that the school has built about how well it aligns with each Standard for Accreditation. These conclusions will subsequently provide guidance regarding ways to strengthen and support the school's ongoing efforts to improve its practices related to teaching and learning. The visiting team's conclusions, informed by the school's self-study which will be based on the collection and analysis of evidence, ultimately provide the Committee on Public Secondary Schools with information that will affect the school's continued accredited status. I will keep the School Board informed as we progress through the process.

Summer School/Credit Recovery was held the first two weeks following the school year. All students that attended were able to recover lost credit.

Two teachers Zach Provost from the Social Studies Department and Greg Wider from the Language Arts Department attended the AP Summer Institute in St. Johnsbury Vermont and received AP Certification.

The Maintenance Team has been working very hard getting the building in shape for the coming year. The gym floor has been varnished and looks terrific. The remainder of the school looks great as well too. Kudo's to the maintenance staff.

Several teachers will be spending time this summer working on curriculum and special projects. This includes teachers from the Arts Department, Math Department, Social Studies Department, Music Department, and the Science Department. The District Curriculum Coordinator Julie Heon will be involved in some of the work.

Fall Sports Update: Varsity soccer try-outs begin August 14th. Middle school soccer try-outs begin August 28th. Impact concussion baseline testing will be held prior to participation for all middle school athletes, incoming freshman and any other new/returning high school athletes who did not test last year. Mr. Rines continues to keep our practice and main soccer field looking great through these hot summer days and we will once again have one of the top soccer fields in Division IV.
