FY22 WLC Budget Narrative October 27, 2020

WLC's proposed FY22 budget is \$10,413.55 over the adjusted FY21 budget. It restores about 18% of the additional budget cuts that were made at WLC (\$56,967.55) after the last Town Meeting reduced the overall bottom line. The proposed increase is about \$34 per student (current census is at 305 students). Generally, the focus was on restoring learning opportunities for students, supporting effective tools such as software for teachers, as well as maintaining and/or replacing equipment. Highlights of the proposed budget are included below:
