IKFA - EARLY GRADUATION

Category: Priority/Required by Law

Related Policy IKF

The Wilton Lyndeborough Cooperative School Board supports early graduation as a means to earn a high school diploma. Parental involvement for students under the age of 18 is required. The high school principal shall approve such requests if he/she determines that all state and local graduation requirements will be met and that early graduation is related to career and/or educational plans of the student making the request. Students who intend to graduate early must complete the Early Graduate Application at the mid-year point of the year of graduation.

Example: A Junior who would like to graduate at the end of their Junior year will need to complete the paperwork by the end of January. For WLC Graduation Requirements refer to the current student handbook and for minimum Graduation requirements for a NH State Graduation refer to policy IKF.

Upon approval by the high school principal, the minimum 4-unit requirement per year for enrolled students shall be waived and the student shall be awarded a high school diploma.
