• The Facility Manager interview team consisted of: Bill (Budget Chair), Ann and Peter (our day custodians at each building), Tom (principal), Kristina (Superintendent Assistant), Kristie (BA), and myself. We met last Tuesday from 11:45 to 4:00 pm to review application packets and interview candidates. We had eight applications and interviewed five candidates. The applicants presented a wide range of competencies and experience. After careful deliberation, we selected two candidates to move forward as finalists. The next step is to provide a walking tour of our buildings this week where we can also talk with the candidates at a deeper/more specific level. For example, "how will you prioritize the tasks to complete the school locker rooms?" It is an opportunity to also explain further the details of the position, for example, being on call, potential weekends, snow removal, and supervision. The final step is to move one candidate forward to discuss contract specifics with the superintendent and provide an offer of employment. We are very enthusiastic about both of our finalists, and we are fully committed to support the new facility manager to be successful!
