- I have included the Strategic Planning information I sent to the school board from an earlier date. I also spoke with NHSBA regarding the consultants they work with to support school boards with strategic planning. While the cost would be dependent on the scope of the plan, conservative estimates are upwards of \$10,000. The documents I've attached include:

- We successfully worked with a family to tuition their student to WLC. Using the most recent per pupil rate from 2022-23 at \$20,023, our out-of-district tuition rate is set at \$8,000.
- I have informed the Wilton town clerk that our proposal to the school board to accommodate their request to have **elections at WLC** is as follows: We propose to have our WLC students learn remote on Tuesday, November 5th. Teachers will hold their online classes from their classrooms or another location in the school district. We will use the interim to plan the remote day to ensure that it is a successful school day. We also propose to hold the election in our WLC café. We will remove all of the tables and other items to maximize the available space. We will also seal off the remainder of the school using our hallways gates.
- On a side note, I have completed the 10-hour mandatory bus driver classes and am preparing to take the exam. Once this is complete, I will begin the training to drive the 15-passenger bus and progress to the regular bus at some point!
