

## **HP - EMPLOYEE JOB ACTIONS**

Strikes and other forms of job action are unlawful, and a violation of Wilton-Lyndeborough Cooperative School Board Policy. However, if a work stoppage occurs, the Board will keep schools open so long as the health and safety of the students and employees can be assured.

### **Action Regarding Work Stoppage**

The initial decision as to whether or not schools will remain open will be made by the Superintendent or his/her designee in consultation with the Chairperson of the Board. If this consultation is not possible, the Superintendent or his/her designee is authorized to make the decision.

There will be an emergency meeting of the Board during the evening the work stoppage has occurred. If prior warning of a possible stoppage is forthcoming, the Superintendent is authorized to call an emergency School Board meeting to be held in the usual meeting place at 7:00 P.M. on the designated date.

It is expressly understood that no Board member other than the Chairperson (or designee) will issue any press release or statements in regard to the work stoppage.
