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24	The committee reviews the possibilities of various financial options.
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26	A concern is raised by Mr. Vanderhoof that the committee has to be working off of one basic document, all agreed to
27	keep it from being confusing.

31	Modification to non-union benefits
32	Losing contingencies but adding some funds for operational costs
33	Elimination of Alt. Educ. Position
34	Choosing not to do repairs to lockers, door hinges, stair treads and softball fencing
35	Not purchasing athletic equipment
36	Reduction of the middle school counselor position
37	Change in math curriculum funding
38	Elimination of additional library books
39	Not hiring business office staff
40	Reduction in Dues and Fees
41	Reductions in conference and travel as well as some PD for administration
42	Not funding the Supt. Search
43	
44	Discussions about the need for Assistant Principal and Curriculum Coordinator. Questions as to being able to
45	combine responsibilities.

47	Superintendent is tasked to create one document to work from.
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- 49 Debbie Bass- concerned about the reduction in the Alternative Education Specialist position. Indicated that the
- 50 supervising of VLACS classes would require training and was not a simple thing. The Superintendent requested that
