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7           **I.       CALL TO ORDER:**

8   Meeting was called to order at 6:04PM in the WLC Media room; Brianne Lavallee present and  
9   Tiffany Cloutier-Cabral attended remotely.

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12           **II.       ADB-DRUG-FREE WORKPLACE POLICY-REGULATIONS REVIEW:**

13   Ms. Lavallee presented information from research regarding the inclusion of the medicinal  
14   marijuana card statement per request of the board. Finding that due to our acceptance of  
15   Federal Grant Money, we do need to include Medicinal Marijuana as one of the substances in  
16   the policy. Discussion was had whether it should be clarified in policy form or just during staff  
17   training. Ms. Lavallee voiced concern that it should be made as clear as possible to avoid  
18   potential litigation but we can bring the finding to the board and they can have final say. Ms.  
19   Lavallee will also reach out to the NHSBA for legal advice in the matter and bring that to the  
20   next board meeting. Consensus of the committee is to make no changes at this time but bring  
21   the discussion to the Board.  
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23           **III.       OBJECTION TO LIBRARY MATERIALS DISCUSSION:**

24   Ms. Wiley and Ms. Loiselle provided an example procedure prior to the meeting. Discussion  
25   was had regarding the research that went into writing, including using the expertise of fellow  
26   school librarians in our area and information from the NH Librarians Association. Ms. Lavallee  
27   asked if once completed we could post the procedure on the school library webpage so that  
28   parents could access the information, Ms. Wiley stated that was something they could work on.  
29   Further discussion was had regarding the procedure; the consensus of the committee is to have  
30   the entire administration team look at the proposed procedure. The committee will create a  
31   policy that references said procedure and review draft at the next meeting. Ms. Cloutier-Cabral  
32   and Ms. Lavallee thanked Ms. Loiselle and Ms. Wiley for all their hard work and commended the  
33   draft procedure.
