To members of the LCS School Community.

An email went out to all families last night letting families know that there were confirmed cases of COVID-19 for multiple staff persons at the Lyndeborough Central School. There are still staff members seeking test results. The incubation period for the virus was inclusive of at least last Tuesday November 24. In following our protocol, anyone who has been in contact with a person who is suspected or has a confirmed case of COVID-19 will quarantine for 14 days. A good number of the staff at LCS eat lunch together so the possibility of exposure to the whole staff was a consideration in my decision to have students at LCS move to a remote learning model.

I am in contact with the Department of Public Health. There is an investigative team that specifically deals with COVID cases that involve schools. I will look to them to determine if students can come back to school this week or if a quarantine needs to be extended to December 8. I have also contacted each preschool family individually by phone to let them know of the possible direct exposure to their child.

If your child is experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 including but not limited to:

CoughSneezingShortness of breathFatigueMuscle or body achesHeadachesSore ThroatCongestion

New loss of taste or smell Stomach distress Diarrhea

please keep your child away from others and contact your health care provider to see if they recommend a PCR COVID-19 test. Please report those symptom to our school nurse as well at l.gifford@sau63.org.
