SPECIAL EDUCATION

Special Education

Another important part of our special education team is our BCBA and ABA/RBTs. They are part of our RISE and Student Support programs. Therapists work 1:1 or 1:2 in both the regular education classroom and special education setting. The ABA (applied behavior analysis) Therapists and RBT (Registered Behavior Technician) implement various teaching techniques including discrete trial teaching, task analysis, positive behavior management, data collection, verbal behavior, and de-escalation strategies. They model expected behavior and help foster social skill development. The ABAs/RBTs assist students with their daily academics and carry-over lessons from other services. They also teach acceptance and knowledge to students in the regular education classroom.

Our BCBA (Board Certified Behavior Analyst) oversees the ABA/RBT Therapists and provides ongoing support for students. She conducts functional behavior assessments, creates positive behavior support plans which are individualized for each student, and analyzes the program data to ensure student progress. The BCBA has also developed training for the staff. The patience and excitement this group shows for ALL children is beyond measure. They are known throughout the school, especially when they participate in themed activities. They are a lot of fun and we appreciate them for everything they do.
