Riddle of the Week:

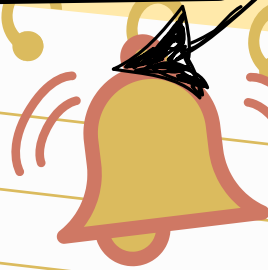
“Nobody empties me, but I never stay full for long. What am I?”
