Incoming students and parents must obtain and complete the following before registering at our schools:

- Unofficial copy of transcript or report card(s) depending on grade
- Birth Certificate
- Immunizations and copy of recent physical
- IEP or 504 Accommodation Plan, if applicable
- Two Proofs of Residency: copy of purchase/lease agreement, property tax bill, or current utility bill indicating a Wilton or Lyndeborough address. *Note:* PO Boxes are not accepted for proof of residency.
- Divorce/Custody Issues: A divorce decree or a parenting plan should be presented at the time of registration.

Legal Residence in Divorce/Custody Matters: In a divorce decree or parenting plan developed pursuant to RSA 461-A, a child's legal residence for school attendance purposes may be the school district which either parent resides, provided the parents agree in writing to the district which the child will attend and each parent furnishes the district with a copy to the school district which the parent resides. The parents shall update their parenting plan to reflect this agreement. (*B*)Nothing in this sub-paragraph shall require a school district to provide transportation for a child to another school in the school district which the child resides or beyond the geographical limits of the school district which the child resides. Both custodial parents and the student must be present during the registration absent a parenting plan

The federal government authorized the McKinney-Vento Act in 2001 as part of No Child Left Behind legislation. Under the McKinney-Vento Act school districts must ensure that homeless children have equal access to the same public education, including public preschool education, as it is provided to other children and youth in the district. Under the Act, "homeless children and youth mean individuals who lack a fixed, regular and adequate nighttime residence. The term includes children and youth who are sharing the housing of other persons due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or similar reasons; are living in motels, hotels, trailer parks, or camping grounds due to the lack of alternative adequate accommodations; are living in emergency or transitionary shelters; are abandoned in hospitals; or are awaiting foster care placement" (Federal Register, march 2002, Volume 67, Number 46). Upon school registration all families will be required to answer questions to identify children who are protected under the McKinney-Vento Act
