Kindergarten Art LCS

We have finished working on a color mixing project with oil pastels for our Twilight Pumpkins (you may view a number of them in the multipurpose room at LCS) and have moved on to a colorful turkey project where we are learning about patterns. Our big turkeys have a lot of colorful feathers and can't wait for Thanksgiving!

All classes at FRES and LCS continue to be busy in the art room moving on from fall-themed projects and starting winter-themed work in anticipation of the holidays.

First Grade Art

The children have finished a collage of a Neon Forest and started another collage (Snowman/woman) in anticipation of the holiday season which involves the color wheel, painting, cutting geometric shapes, and creating moving lines (the principle of design Movement).

Second Grade Art

With a focus on the artist Yayoi Kusama, the students drew and painted large pumpkins and applied polka dots on them in the style of the famous artist who is known as the Princess of Polka Dots! The children have started making Gingerbread People, which is an annual project for 2nd grade. They will use brown paper for the cookie, white paint for the frosting, oil pastels for the colored frosting and finally some glitter.

Third Grade Art

Third graders have finished an oil pastel drawing inspired by images of the artist Beverly Buchanan. The artist had a unique way of using color which involves a lot of short lines and controlled scribbles. The students are using their awesome design skills to make the small decorations for our annual Christmas tree.

Fourth Grade Art

Fourth-grade students finished their Day of the Dead sugar skulls and are making their annual holiday project which is a Folk Art Santa using tempera paints and oil pastels. Traditional patterns are used on Santa's coat and hat. Winter is almost here!

Fifth Grade Art

Fifth graders completed two autumn projects. One with a focus on warm and cool colors. By contrasting colors they created the illusion of leaves that have fallen on water while it is raining. The second project focused on value changes using the orange color family in which the students viewed a pumpkin, observed the shape and various light and dark areas that occur when light falls on it. They are currently working on some holiday decorations in preparation for the winter concert.
