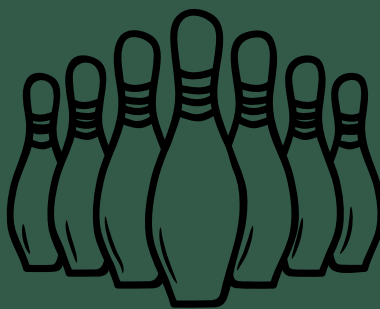
# P.E. CLASS WITH MR. SHENK
