Welcome back!

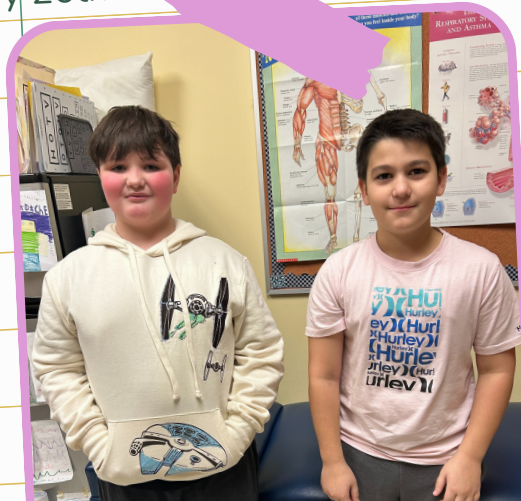
After a well deserved holiday break we are excited to welcome back all of our amazing students at FRES.
